- Led a Remembrance Day Service in the Toowoomba Residential Facility and at Gatton BlueCare Centre.
- Visited a growing number of community clients through the Wellbeing Support Service.
- Had regular catch ups with ministers and chaplains either in person, by email or phone.
- Led the Christmas Service in Toowoomba Residential Facility.
- Led a Christmas Carol Service at Gatton BlueCare Centre.
- Have provided emotional and spiritual support to a number of staff in residential and community.
- Preached at Nobby and Wilsonton Uniting Churches.
- Supported clients, families and staff involved in clients going through Voluntary Assisted Dying.
- Given support to families of residents at Toowoomba Residential Facility.
- Visited residents and clients in hospital.
